Murugan Medal

The Canadian Atlantic Section will provide a Bronze Medal in memory of the 1983-1984 Section Chair, Gnanendran Murugan, to be presented annually to the member who best demonstrates the qualities of professionalism, integrity, and dedication to the purposes of the IEEE. It is not necessary for the Medal to be awarded every year.

Life Member Lifetime Service Award

The Life Member Lifetime Service Award is presented to a Section Life Member who has contributed significantly to IEEE throughout their career, shown leadership in IEEE-designated fields of interest, or otherwise embodies the IEEE Mission & Vision of "advancing technology for the benefit of humanity." The Life Member Lifetime Service Award is only awarded when a suitable nominee is found and may not be awarded in any given year.

Outstanding Engineering Achievement Award

The Canadian Atlantic Section will provide an Outstanding Engineering Achievement Award, in the form of a plaque, to an outstanding engineer recognized by the Canadian Atlantic Section who has shared their technical and professional abilities (in industry, government or an institution of higher learning) and, in doing so, has made an outstanding contribution to engineering within the territory of the Canadian Atlantic Section. The outstanding engineering achievement award may not be awarded in any particular year.

Outstanding Industrial Contribution Award

The Canadian Atlantic Section will provide an Outstanding Industrial Contribution Award, in the form of a plaque, to an industry professional and practitioner in an area of significant interest and importance to the IEEE residing within the territory of the IEEE Canadian Atlantic Section who, through technical abilities and professional conduct, has made an outstanding contribution to the technology profession in the Canadian Atlantic Section. The Outstanding Industrial Contribution Award may not be awarded in any particular year.

Outstanding Engineering Education Award

The Canadian Atlantic Section will provide an Outstanding Engineering Education Award, in the form of a plaque, to an outstanding individual or organization recognized by the CAS who has shared their professional and educational abilities (in the private sector or an institution of higher learning), and, in doing so, has made an outstanding contribution to engineering and technical education within the territory of the Canadian Atlantic Section.
