# How to get there?

### By car

#### By car coming from Brussels

- Take the highway E40 (Brussel-Luik), direction Luik.
- Take the exit "E314 Leuven-Hasselt-Genk" between exit 22 (Bertem) and exit 23 (Haasrode).
- Keep to the right and immediately take the exit number 15 (Leuven).
- At the third traffic light, turn right on the Celestijnenlaan.
- Turn right on the Kapeldreef, you're now on Campus Heverlee.

#### By car coming from Luik (Liège)

- Take the highway E40 (Brussel-Luik), direction Brussel.
- Follow the E314 direction Genk, Hasselt, Leuven.
- Keep to the right and take the exit number 15 (Leuven).
- At the third traffic light, turn right on the Celestijnenlaan.
- Turn right on the Kapeldreef, you're now on Campus Heverlee.

#### By car coming from Hasselt/Genk/Aken/Maastricht

- Take the highway E314 (Aken-Leuven).
- Keep to the right and take the exit number 15 (Leuven).
- At the third traffic light, turn right on the Celestijnenlaan.
- Turn right on the Kapeldreef, you're now on Campus Heverlee.

There is limited parking space available near the building. You need an entrance code to Parking De Molen.

## By bus from the train station

- Take bus number 1 Heverlee or bus number 2 Campus.
- Exit at the terminus.
- Bus number 616 (Zaventem) also serves the campus.
- The bus schedule can be consulted here

### By train

- The timetables are available here.
- You will arrive at the railway station of Leuven, where you can take a taxi or a bus (see 'by bus') to the campus.
- Coming from abroad:
- Thalys Paris Nord (1h25'), Köln HBF (2h30'), Amsterdam (2h40'), Rotterdam (1h40')
- Eurostar London Waterloo (2h40'), Lille Europe (40')
- Please note: make sure you do not confuse Leuven (called "Louvain" in French and English) with its French-speaking variant Louvain-la-Neuve.
