Description

On the occasion of IEEE Day, Orientation of IEEE of BE - CSE students with group A held at Chenab Hall (104) on 03 October 2022.

At about 10:00 AM, the event started with presentation of IEEE chair Aditya Sharma. He explained benefits of IEEE membership and also gave his personal advice to students about Academics.
