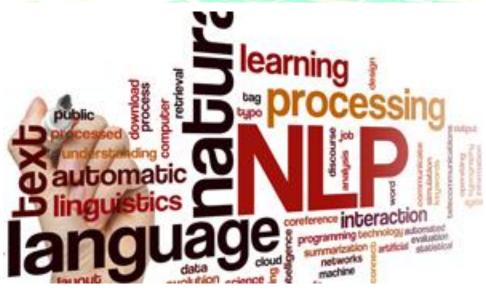
Presents an Industry talk on Al for Everyone
