# EmpowHer - A Blog Writing Competition Empower through words!

"Unleash your pen, ignite your voice, and let your words create magic."

On the occasion of IEEE WIE day, **WIE IEEE SBNU** organized a blog writing competition, on 9th July, 2023. It was an online event and open for all universities Nationwide.

This event was **co-sponsored by WIE Gujarat Section**. Registrations were taken through google form and about 191 students registered. Registered candidates were given guidelines and themes for the event on 2th July and they were required to submit their blogs along with images, and media files that they intend to include in their blog in a zip file via mail till 4th July 11:59 pm.

The theme of the event was "Engaging Women in Mitigating Climate Change & Building Climate Resilience"- which is the theme of this WIE Day.

Thereafter their blogs were published on a medium account through IEEE SBNU's official account and the credits were given to the respective blogs.

From 5th July to 8th July 12 noon, they were given time to publicize their blogs on any social media platform.

In the closing ceremony which was held on 9th July 2023 11 am the results were declared.

The overall reach made by the candidates through their blog was 8354.

# Judging Criteria:

- The reach and engagement of the published blogs were considered for the judging process.
- The top 15 blogs with the highest reach (based on factors such as likes, comments, share follows, and overall engagement) were selected as finalists.
- The judging panel evaluated the content quality, originality, clarity, depth of insights, and the ability to engage and educate readers.
- The judges' decision on the Winner, Runner-Up, and Best Female Winner was be based on the aforementioned criteria and the overall impact generated by the published blogs.
- The judges' decision was final and cannot be contested.

# Winners Selection:

After the top 15 blogs were identified, they were sent for evaluation to a judge - Prof. Jainee Shah ma'am from the Humanities Department, ITNU.

She independently reviewed and rated blogs out of 10 according to the quality of content, originality, clarity, depth of insights, and the

ability to engage and educate readers. Based on her judgment Winner, Runner-up and Best Female Writer were chosen.
