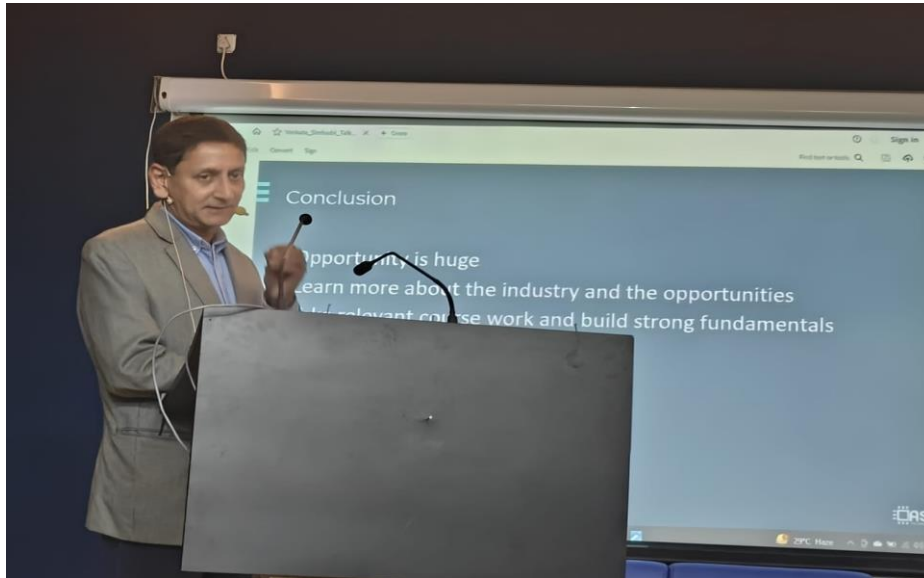


Indian Semicon Talent Vision
