

## IEEE India Council – IIT Guwahati Campus Immersion Program 2024

in association with IEEE Guwahati SubSection

21st June 2024 - 3rd July 2024

### Objective

To provide a two-week on-campus experience with exposure to the state-of-the-art infrastructure and a platform for interaction with domain experts for the meritorious students of premier engineering institutes in India.

### Program Overview

The program consists of a 14-day long stay at IIT Guwahati campus along with professional events consisting of technical talks by domain experts from India and foreign, academia, and industry to provide students a bird-eye-view of emerging technologies and how to approach engineering studies in the modern scientific world.

### Who can participate?

The program is open for B.Tech students from CSE, ECE or allied branches of 2023 admission year (first year) with minimum 8.5 CPI. Applications are accepted only through nomination of HoD/faculty. Direct applications from students will not be accepted.

### Nomination Process

A list of nominated students' details (name, email-id, CPI) has to be emailed to the program coordinator by the faculty/HoD before 1st June 2024. A maximum of four students can be nominated from a college. Once the nomination is received, a registration form will be shared with the students from the organizing team at IIT Guwahati.

### Highlights

- Domain talks from IIT Guwahati faculty, industry experts, foreign university faculty
- Career guidance and personality counseling sessions
- Visit to the state-of-the-art laboratories, supercomputing facility, and library infrastructure of IIT Guwahati
- Interaction with research scholars
- Group learning activities
- 2 week stay at IIT Guwahati campus

### Registration Fee

A program fee of INR 9800/- has to be paid by the student. This fee includes twin-sharing hostel accommodation in IIT Guwahati hostels, local pick-up and drop-off at Guwahati, and one community dinner on the concluding day. Daily dining expenses are not covered in this fee. Participants can avail pay-and-eat facility of IITG hostels.
