The event concluded with the speaker explaining the steps to take after a fraud occurs, including utilizing government-provided services such as contacting helpline numbers like 1903, online cybercrime outline portals and outlining the necessary actions for retrieval. Later all the attendees participated in an engaging Q/A discussion to address their concerns about the technology and were provided with a guide and important contact details to defend themselves from cybercrime so that they can share and remember the essential procedure. After the event, refreshments were served, allowing attendees to network and further discuss the topics covered.
