To make their day more joyful, the volunteers introduced residents to a thrilling experience of Virtual Reality (VR), by offering them a firsthand experience of how far technology has come. For many of them, it was their first time exploring such immersive digital technology, which brought wide smiles to their faces. Thereafter, one of the team members had a brief awareness session about the risks of scam messages and fraud calls, alerting them not to share their personal data and OTP with these types of cyber criminals.

They received heartfelt blessings and valuable advice from the elders, concluding the visit with hearts full of warmth and cherished memories.
