To the San Diego Section Executive Committee,

The IEEE at UC San Diego is seeking funding to provide undergraduate students the opportunity to attend the 2026 Rising Stars Conference, which will be held from January 2nd to the 4th at the Luxor Hotel in Las Vegas.

Our student branch currently comprises 28 undergraduate students from diverse backgrounds, majors, and professional aspirations. We aim to support students across the county and collaborate with student branches to advance the IEEE's missions. The Rising Stars conference offers our officers the chance to enhance their professional skills through workshops, networking opportunities, a project showcase, and more. These experiences can be shared with students through various events and serve to promote IEEE to prospective members who are interested in the organization.

Rising Stars is the largest conference in the nation for students and young professionals, attracting attendees from across the country who gather in Las Vegas to provide various opportunities to the aforementioned students and young professionals. IEEE at UCSD has consistently participated in the conference, with many previous officers volunteering or becoming young professionals.

We have submitted a request for funding to the IEEE's University Partnership Program for this year. Following a brief discussion and an in-depth meeting, we were able to secure funding for four students to attend the event. Additionally, UPP will cover the costs of projects, providing us with at least \$1810. The four students who will attend serve as the executive committee members of our club. We aim to secure funds for additional students through the IEEE SD Section, IEEE PACE, and various UC San Diego departments to join us and showcase our annual project, Robocup. We intend to send the leads of the annual project to the conference. This will enable us to address any necessary maintenance on the spot and allow the four key members to demonstrate their dedication and hard work over the past two years.

IEEE San Diego Section funds 8 students from the section to attend rising stars, covering the cost of the 8 registrations and 2 hotel rooms which if done with the PACE discount and completed prior to 09/28/2025 would total the section \$3416.38.
