Summary of the Event

The **Paper Tech Talk** was an innovative and interactive session aimed at enhancing students' public speaking confidence and promoting peer-to-peer technical knowledge sharing. The event was designed to provide a platform where participants could express their thoughts on trending technology topics in a spontaneous yet supportive environment.

The session was structured in two main parts:

First, an Introduction and Format Briefing, where the organizers explained the objectives, rules, and flow of the event. Students learned how they would submit their own tech-related topics, pick one randomly submitted by another participant, and speak about it on the spot. This segment helped participants understand the unique format and encouraged them to think creatively and without fear.

Second, the Micro-Talk Presentations and Evaluation, where each student got a chance to speak for 1–2 minutes on their selected topic after a brief preparation time. This segment focused on originality, expression, and confidence rather than technical depth. The talks were evaluated by a faculty judge, ensuring fair and constructive feedback and recognizing standout performances.

The **Paper Tech Talk** provided a lively and educational experience, helping students sharpen their communication skills, build confidence in impromptu speaking, and exchange knowledge on current and emerging technology trends in a relaxed setting.






How would you rate the overall experience of "Paper Tech Talk"? 9 responses


How was the time allotted for thinking and speaking?
