What are vTools?

Brief definition and overview

- "vTools" stands for "Volunteer Tools."
- vTools simplify and automate many of the administrative tasks to our volunteers via the use of online tools, reduce time spent managing activities, and assist in member development.
- Volunteers can create meetings/events, websites, send emails, run elections, and more.
- vTools are free to use for volunteers.



Who Can Access vTools?

Automatic access is granted for the following roles

- Region Directors
- Region Executive Committee Members
- Region-level Representatives (e.g. Students, YP, WIE)
- Section, Chapter, Affinity Group Executive Committee Members (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, Treasurer)
- Student Branch and HKN Executive Committee Members (includes Advisor, Counselor)
- Membership Development (MD) Chair

- Council Chairs
- SAMIEEE Recipient for OU Analytics and vTools
- eNotice Coordinator access limited to eNotice only
- vTools Events Coordinator access limited to Events only
- vTools Coordinator*
- Newsletter Editor*
- Webmaster*


Quick overview of each of the vTools Applications



eNotice

https://enotice.vtools.ieee.org

- Electronic messaging service where volunteers can email their members about local events
- Supports Regions, Councils, Sections, Chapters,
 Affinity Groups, Student Branches and Student
 Branch Chapters, Societies, Technical Communities
- All recipients included are GDPR and member communication preferences compliant
- Features:
 - Express delivery within two (2) hours
 - Events/eNotice integration
 - Automatic email reminders
 - Personalization of messages (e.g., "Dear <FN><LN>")
 - Customization of "From" and "Reply to"
 - Footer includes
 - Target OU's URL (if available)
 - Option to manage communication preferences
 - Send Test eNotice eNotice sent to volunteer





Events

https://events.vtools.ieee.org

- Create and promote local meetings and events
- Supports Regions, Councils, Sections, Chapters, Affinity Groups, Student Branches and Student Branch Chapters, Societies
- Collect registration, fees
 - Connected to Concentration Banking Accounts (NextGen)
- Event/eNotice integration
 - Create eNotice from Event information
 - Send email reminders to event attendees for a single event
- Feeds (RSS, HTML, XML) Collabratec, IEEE mobile app, Section website
- Report meetings/events to IEEE headquarters (L31)
 - One click to submit one report for all hosts
 - Reports submitted into Annual Section Rebate vTools application






Nominations

https://nominations.vtools.ieee.org/

- Launched in Q4 2021.
- Created for IEEE volunteers to help them select eligible candidates to be on the ballot for an upcoming election.
- Currently only supports Section and Chapter Nomination and Petition processes.
 - Support for other units will be added in the future.
- Candidates can automatically be moved from Nominations > Voting > Officer Reporting.






Voting

https://voting.vtools.ieee.org/

- Volunteers create ballots (elections or motions) for local geo unit elections
- Supports Sections, Chapters, Affinity Groups, Student Branches, Technical Committees, MGA Committees
- Features:
 - Dashboards Active, Draft, Past
 - Ballot
 - Creation of multiple positions with multiple candidates
 - Auto-load voter list of eligible members for Organization holding election
 - Preview online ballot as DRAFT
 - PDF/Print versions of ballot available
- Once election is open, organizer can email voters directly from tool
- Once election has closed, review/report election results, add manual votes
- Members sign in with IEEE Account for secure access to online ballot






Officer Reporting

https://officers.vtools.ieee.org/

- Allows volunteers to submit or update officers for their
 OU
- Supports Regions, Councils, Sections, Sub-sections,
 Chapters, Affinity Groups, Student Branches, IEEE Eta Kappa Nu (HKN)
- Updates Volunteer Positions in OU Analytics and IEEE Organizational Roster*
- Instantaneous updates to the IEEE Membership database when submitted by authorized volunteers
- Officers have automatic access once report is saved
- Features:
 - View organizational roster
 - O Automatic validation of Member Grade, OU affiliation
 - Add and/or End term of an officer
 - View Officer Logs of organizational roster changes
 - Update Organizational Unit URL (website)






Engage

https://engage.vtools.ieee.org

- Launched in November 2022.
- vTools Engage is an interactive relationship management solution that captures data for IEEE members and non-members.
- It enables volunteers to engage, track, and retain members, convert nonmembers to members, and provide volunteers the information they need to offer the best programs possible.
- Support Sections and Chapters.
 - Support for other units will be added in the future.






Local Groups

https://vtools.vtools.ieee.org

- Launched in Q4 2021.
- A Local Group is an IEEE Organizational Unit that is a sub-unit of a Section, focused on a specified local interest such as Blockchain or HAM Radio.
- A Local Group shall comprise a minimum of two (2) IEEE members, one of whom must be an IEEE voting member, and both of whom must be members of the geographic unit involved.
- The Local Group requires approval by the Section Chair.
- A Collabratec Workspace is created where Local Group members can collaborate and invite others to join.
- Both IEEE members and non-members may be participants of the Local Group.






Student Branch Reporting

https://sbr.vtools.ieee.org/

- Student Branch Officers submit plans for upcoming year
- Supports Student Branches
 - Student Branch Chapters are not required to submit annual plans.
- Features:
 - Student officers (Branch Chair, Counselor, Section Chair, Region Student Representative) provide approval of submitted plans
 - Plan details (i.e., Branch Operations / Function, Goals, Activities planned)
 - Search submitted plans, download PDF versions of a plan
- Planned events are reported in vTools Events






WebInABox

- Basic web site creation tool with wizard-like interface
- Supports Sections, Chapters, Student Branches, and Affinity Groups
- No webmaster required
- Enables a common look-and-feel compliant with IEEE web presence/branding guidelines
- Integrates with vTools Events includes upcoming and past events
- Data driven with auto updates from central IEEE database including Officer Roster and website URLs
- Provides file storage






Xtreme

https://xtreme.vtools.ieee.org/

- IEEEXtreme is a 24-hour global challenge in which teams of IEEE Student members compete against each other to solve a set of programming problems.
- Advised and proctored by an IEEE member, and often supported by an IEEE Student Branch.
- vTools Xtreme provides the registration process for proctors and teams
- Team information is provided to competition platform
- Features:
 - Member eligibility Student and Graduate Student Members, school attending status
 - Proctor Registration and validation
 - Team Registration
 - Email confirmations to team admins, proctors, and team members








IEEE OU Analytics

- Provides access to IEEE Membership statistics as well as member information for your unit
- Important tool to help you with member development
 - Know your members and membership trends
 - Use data to drive engagement and revitalization
- Access is based on the volunteer's position and Organizational Unit (OU)
 - Sections: Chair, vice chair, secretary, treasurer, MD and SAC chairs
 - Chapters, Joint Chapters, and Affinity Groups: Chair
 - Student branches: Branch chair and counselor
 - Recipients can be added upon request
- All volunteers can access the Map module, Doublet dashboard, and memberships and subscriptions monthly statistics
- Use must be in accordance with IEEE Data Access and Use Policy
 - Member information can only be used for approved IEEE business
 - It may not be furnished to outside entities
