Mementos were presented by IEEE Bhubaneswar chapter excom members to all participants.



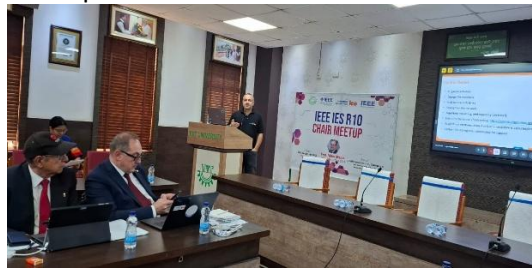
