

AWARENESS SESSION ON NASSCOM AI-CODE SARATHI

The awareness session on “**Nasscom AI-Code Sarathi**” was conducted online on 4th March 2025, Wednesday, starting at 6:40 PM.

The session was organized by SAC, IEEE Hyderabad Section. Digvijay, Joint-SSR, SAC, IEEE Hyderabad Section, introduced the speaker, Mr. Pankaj Diwan, who delivered the session.

The session aimed to inform participants about the Nasscom AI-Code Sarathi program - a free, 4-hour live online AI coding workshop supported by Google, with Idealabs as the ecosystem partner and TalentFarm.ai as the platform partner. The initiative is designed to enhance AI skills among students and certify colleges for AI readiness.

KEY TAKEAWAYS FROM THE MEETING

- The Nasscom AI-Code Sarathi program is a free, live, hands-on AI coding workshop.
- Duration: 4 hours; Mode: Online, live trainer-based.
- Schedule: Colleges can choose slots between **9th March and 20th March**, and students can also register individually through the portal.
- Workshop timings: **9:30 AM to 10:30 PM** (multiple slots available).
- Mentors: Senior industry practitioners recommended by Nasscom.
- Program structure:
 - Phase 1: Workshop
 - Phase 2: Hackathon
 - Phase 3: Mentoring program
- Certificates will be provided to participants; colleges will be recognized for AI readiness.
- The program is open to **all students and developers**, and **no prior knowledge of coding is required**.
- Exclusive recognition and felicitation of colleges will be done at a physical event by Nasscom, based on participation percentage.
- Registration methods:
 - Method 1 (Registration by College):** Colleges can fill in the details of interested participants, and the Idealabs team will complete the registration process on TalentFarm.ai.
 - Method 2 (Direct Registration):** Students can register individually on the Nasscom portal.
