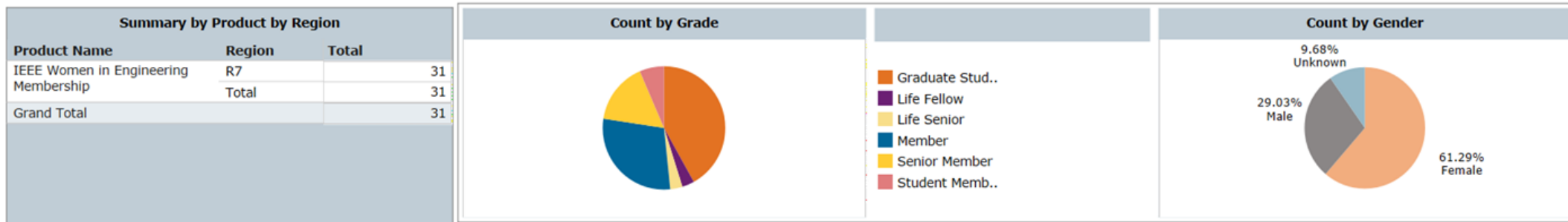

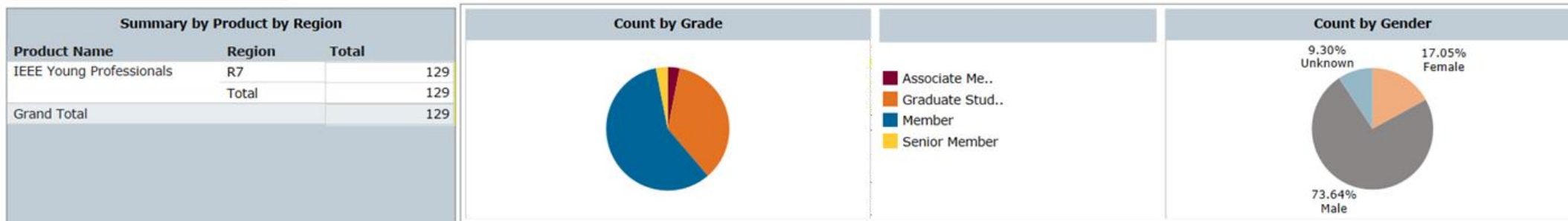

Reflection on the Sections Congress 2020

- **The MGA Board considered Sections Congress 2020 event options in June meeting:**
 - A virtual 2020 Recommendations Process would be conducted in 2020
 - SC 2020 would be held as one or more virtual events over the next 12 months
 - The next Sections Congress be held as planned for 2023
- **The SC 2020 Committee plans exciting virtual SC events and schedule**
 - The Virtual Recommendation Process held in September 1 to 15.
Top 3 Recommendations were voted by primary delegates and announced on Sept. 15.
 - *Create a 3-5 multi-year IEEE membership fee structure with discounts
 - *Provide continuing education to provide true value added for working professionals
 - *Provide resources to Sections to serve industry professionals and engage with local industries
